29 November 2018

1st December 2018

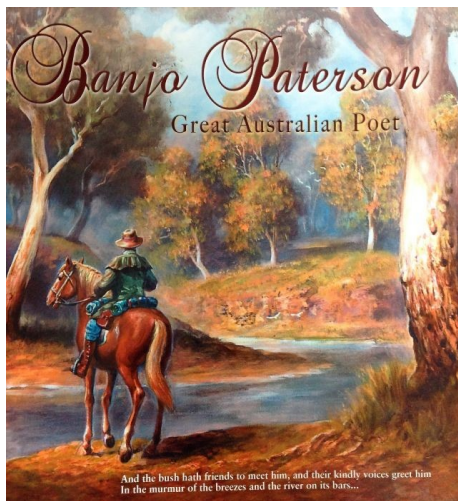
Cherry Festival
